Community Director Ron advised that the committee had forwarded \$500 towards materials for Wheelchairs for Kids. The wheelchairs cost \$100 to make and 200 are done each month via volunteers. Ray gave an update on the Fairholme project in Berehaven Avenue, including a sketch plan received from Barry Winterbourne.

Mike introduced Carolyn Dryland to speak on Southside care, a not for profit organization which looks after young people with disabilities and the frail aged. They also offer community welfare assistance through budgeting, food parcels and advocacy. Based at 18a Gillam Drive Kelmscott to enhance the quality of life of people in the community, also offering support to carers; domestic assistance; social support; respite care and day centre outings, the operating costs being HACC funded. In question time there appeared the need for two specially designed chairs.
