Ray Smith then gave a very detailed description on how Ute's evolved and then fined President Andy for having one.

Chairman Vin introduced Angela who opened her discussion with an acknowledgement to the traditional owners of the land. She herself is Noongar and although only has four children herself has an extensive family of step children and grandchildren. Her father migrated from the UK in 1924 and her Mother was one of the stolen generation and was sent to a mission in Wandering to be trained as a domestic. Angela was also removed from her parents and was placed at Wandering and Rawling Missions.

Her paid work is with Relationship WA which identifies children exposed to domestic violence and she is also a Policy Officer at the Drug and Alcohol Association.

LAA is community based and the building is leased from the City of Gosnells and survives on fund raising and grants to achieve outcomes. Although she grew up in less than ideal conditions she is now in a position to give back to the community. There are identified gaps between indigenous people and the rest of the population as in the Lowest Burt weights, High imprisonment rates and Dependency on Drugs and Alcohol.

Some programmes available are for:-

- 5 year olds to prepare them for kindergarten and progressing to school.
- Men's groups to build up there esteem.
- Youth groups meet Tuesday and Thursday afternoons and are kept occupied with sport and recreation.

Funding is provided from Criminal Confiscation to provide the ability to work with youths aged between 8-20 years of age to deter them from using drugs.

The women, who are strong in the community aim to make it better for their children.

A reminder to **all of those that have not completed their Police Clearances** and so far out of 26 only 12 have done so, which means that 14 of you have got guilty consciences.

President Andy provided information on the Premier's Australia Day Active Citizenship Awards 2008, which is calling for nominations to recognize community members that have made outstanding contributions to the local community.
