Rod Styles address the club on the Rotary Youth Drivers awareness program and the requirements for the club and members in taking the program onboard emphasising the objective was to deal with developing brain and attitudes of adolescents who were at a very difficult age.

The program for the Thornlie Senior High School was scheduled for the 24th of February 2009

As part of the program, students will pay \$15 towards costs and will attend six sessions in the one day giving an overview of each of the following

- Stopping distances. The impact of differing speeds, reaction time and vehicle traction on stopping time and distance
- Hazard perception. Establishing what hazards are and strategies for the anticipation and avoidance of them
- Safe celebrating and fatigue. Demonstrations of the effects of drugs, alcohol and fatigue on reaction times and decision making ability.
- Your choice. A video, chaired by the Police, of an 18yr old who is killed as a result of poor choice and decision making
- Crashes do happen. Presentation by crash survivors and histories of life changes as a result of accidents
- Finance and Insurance

It was emphasised that the program would require careful planning, site selection and the involvement of about eight club members on the proposed day
