Born on the 31st October 1947 at The Vicarage in Llanhowell, Wales

Following migration to Australia, February 1965 saw Ted gain employment as a cadet draftsman with the then Metropolitan Water Supply Department.

In 1970, following graduation as a Civil Engineering he was appointed an Engineer with the Metropolitan Water Board

Ted has remained with what is now known as the Water Authority, for more than 43 years

Today, Ted leads a team of 40 engineers and technical officers that are responsible for 11,000kms of water and 9,000kms of sewerage mains, along with 600 wastewater-pumping stations, managing assets in excess of \$6 billion and providing services for more than 1.5 million people.

Rotary

Ted joined the Rotary Club of Wanneroo in 1978 and since that date has enjoyed continuous Rotary service.

While with Wanneroo, Ted served with that club's board on four separate occasions

Apart from his positions with the Rotary Club of Wanneroo's Board, Ted volunteered to be that club's bulletin editor in 1995/96.

Current Wanneroo Rotarians remember Ted's eight years membership with a lot of affection and reported Ted as a well-respected and excellent Rotarian

Resigning in 1996, moving south of the river to Canning Vale where he and Lois could get serious about their "hobby" of breeding Corgis, thus Wanneroo's loss was Thornlie's gain; Ted joined the Rotary Club of Thornlie in June 1996.

Since arriving at Thornlie among other appointments Ted has served as a board member on four separate occasions.

During his 30 years of Rotary Service Ted has been a contributing Board Member on eight different occasions, an outstanding example of **"Service Above Self"**

As a direct result of many years service to both the community of Western Australia and Rotary, Ted, it gives us much pleasure in naming you a Paul Harris Fellow.
