Doug Parker gave a brief summary of the joint funding of the Prem Bank PHD Scholarship. This is a three year commitment between Thornlie Rotary – ARHF and UWA. This Scholarship Awardee has given presentations in other states and this is now becoming a nationally recognised achievement.

Treasurer Wayne, gave detail of the Club's finances and explained why the Board had set up an Administration account to pay the costs of running the Club. A list of these expenses was circulated to members. An exclusion to this will be the cost of cleaning at Bring'N'Buy, which is now paid in cash withdrawn from the takings each week. Changes to the GST rules mean that the Club will no longer pay quarterly instalments. This will necessitate a re print of the receipt books and Stall Holders can no longer claim GST credits.

A brief discussion re the Helen Hosking Memorial Fund resulted in a decision not to add to the capital at this time.

PDG Ron Sloan reported on his attempts to involve either Westfarmers or Coles in the proposed Literacy Project. Neither organization showed any interest in this type of Community Project. Ron has now decided to prepare a submission to Fortescue Metals for their support.
