Just a little reminder of one of Pres Elect Ron's little fantasies.

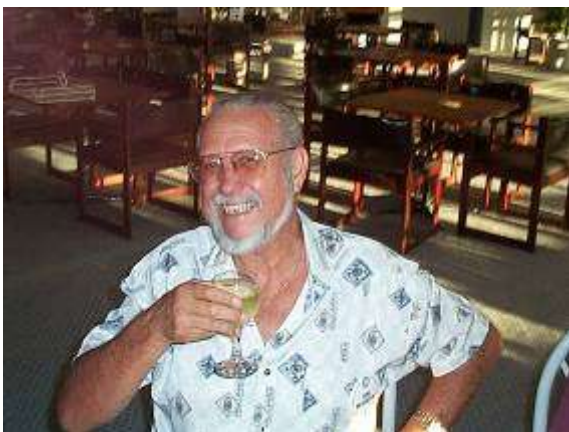
