**Ian** spoke about the dinner at UWA with Chris and Colin regarding the Research Foundation and the Rotary Milk Bank. There are still some problems during pasteurisation, which they hope to sort out soon.

Our guest speakers Candi and Mark from the Office of Crime Prevention, told us about their work, particularly the Burglar Beware campaign.

This is part of the state governments crackdown on the high rate of burglaries in WA. The key elements being:

- Marketing and use of media.
- Targeted police operations.
- Public appeals such as Dob-in-a-burglar week.
- New forensic techniques.
- Stolen goods strategy.
- Eyes on the Street intelligence gathering initiative.
- Local inter-agency implementation teams.

Other things they are looking at include: truancy; youth diversity programs; and parenting programs. The Burglar Beware program is enlisting volunteers, who will be trained by the police to assist victims of burglary and help with the program in general.
